

JAF LUTTRELL MEMORIAL CHARITY

The Charity would like it to be known that there is no connection between the J A F Luttrell Memorial Charity and the estate of the late Adrian Moon (Mostyn Owen Estate) and any of the land and property currently up for auction.

Mrs Margaret Luttrell of Edington Manor set up a Cottage Hospital and Dispensary in Redlands Lane, Edington, in memory of her husband John Alexander Fownes and the charity was established in 1898. In 1981 when the building was sold the capital from the sale was then invested to provide an income for the charity. It is the dividends from this portfolio which provide the Charity's income.

The prime purpose of this charity is to award grants to individuals in need in the area of benefit (Edington, Catcott, Chilton Polden, Burtle and Cossington) but also general grants for the general benefit of the inhabitants, through organisations, associations and schools.
